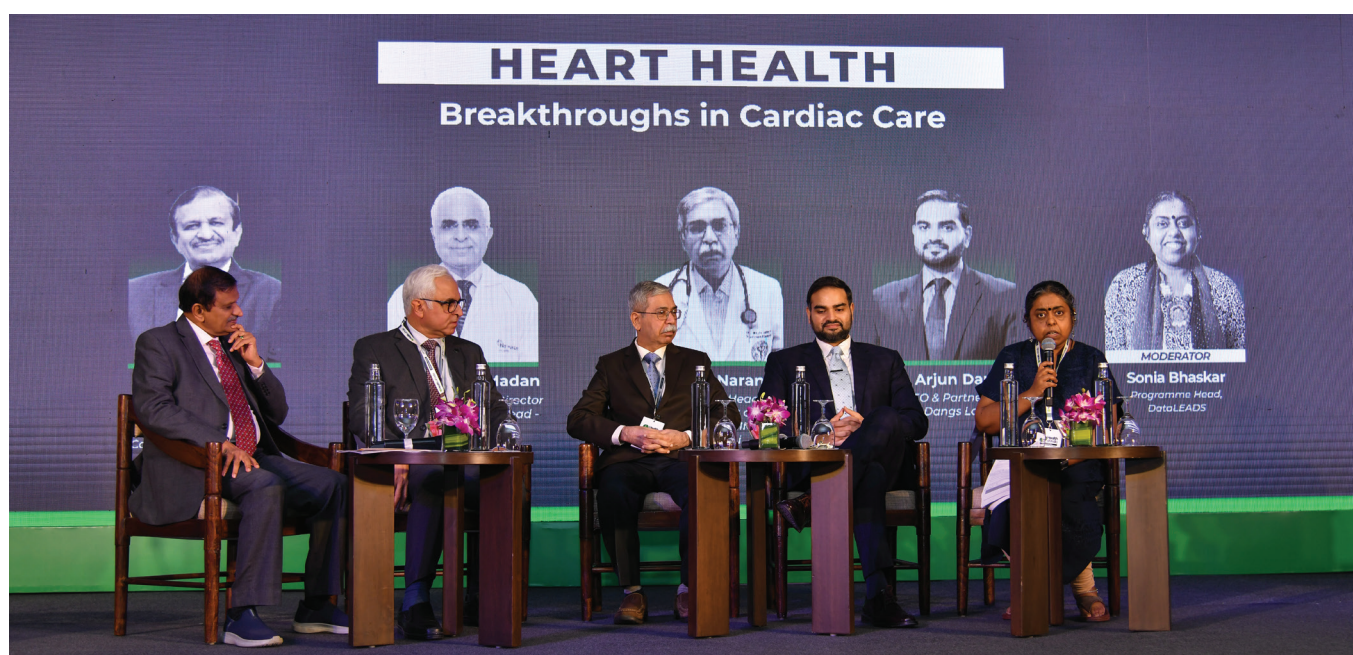


As more people seek health information online, the rapid spread of health misinformation has become a pressing issue. In this context, it is crucial for diverse stakeholders to come together and find common ground to tackle the problem effectively.

The Health of India Summit 2024 convened policymakers, healthcare industry leaders, doctors, public health specialists, entrepreneurs, AI and technology experts, journalists, and other concerned stakeholders to propose and discuss actionable strategies to address the growing tide of health misinformation. The summit saw 383 registrations from across India, with 182 delegates attending the in-person event in Delhi on December 3, 2024.

Featuring over 31 speakers and thought leaders, the summit explored a range of critical topics, including accelerating R&D innovation, breakthroughs in cardiac care, AI and health, rising cancer cases in India, and the impact of air pollution on health.

Additionally, the summit marked the release of a report titled Health Misinformation Vectors in India, published by Spotlight—the Trust and Safety and Data Intelligence unit of DataLEADS. Discussions among the diverse panelists offered valuable insights and underscored the need for a collaborative approach and multidisciplinary thinking to develop holistic solutions for modern healthcare challenges.

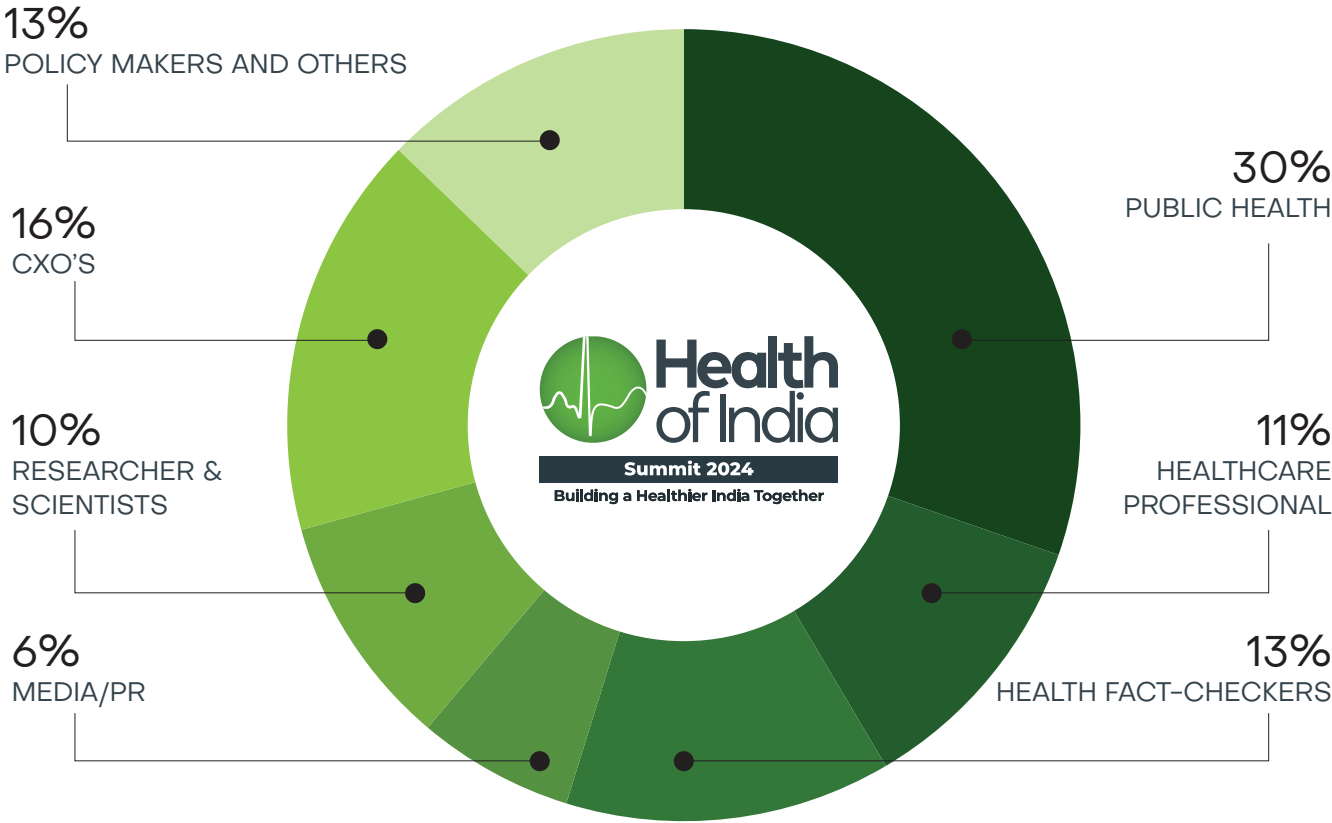

HEALTH MISINFORMATION VECTORS IN INDIA

A high-level, insight-based report by Spotlight in collaboration with First Check

A new high-level, insight-based report by Spotlight in collaboration with First Check, **Health Misinformation Vectors in India**, was released at the Health of India Summit.

The report illustrated, in great detail, how a general reluctance toward conventional medicine, coupled with the widespread availability and affordability of natural remedies, often draws individuals away from evidence-based treatments. Faith and local traditions, deeply ingrained in the social fabric, further influence health-seeking behaviors, sometimes reinforcing misinformation. These factors are compounded by the absence of localized policies designed to effectively counter health-related misinformation online.

It emphasized the detrimental effects of such misinformation on public health and medical decisions, and urged stricter regulations, better local health worker training, and leveraging technology to improve health literacy to counter vaccine misinformation.
